### ST. PETER & SAN CONRADO MISSION. SCALABRINI OUTREACH ANNUAL PROGRAM SUMMARY OF SERVICES -2016

**The Scalabrini Outreach Program has a long history of serving the needs of the most vulnerable:** the homeless, migrant and families that just need a bit of help during a difficult time. **THANK YOU!** Your gifts of time and money make this possible.

**12,000 meals** were distributed to small missions in downtown Los Angeles, Orange and Ventura Counties. (Nothing is wasted)

The Scalabrini **Food bank** is open the 1st & 3rd Friday of each month and serves an **average of 100 families per day**. The families served are English, Spanish and Asian speaking immigrant families. Our thanks to St. Bridget's Church who assist with translation.

Each Tuesday we provided meals **(3,600) and assistance to Day Labor programs** for migrants in search of work at various Home Depots and missions of charity in the Los Angeles area.

**500-1000 meals were prepared the last Saturday of the month** for distribution in **Skid row and homeless encampments. (9000 +meals).** **300+ blankets** were distributed on the streets of Downtown LA, Orange and Ventura Counties during **cold weather**.

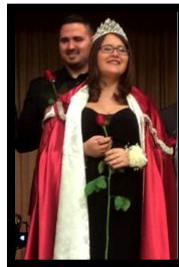
**1300 meals and 400 baskets** were distributed at our **Thanksgiving celebration. 500 meals** were prepared to assist with **Our Lady of the Holy Rosary's Day Labor celebration. Thanksgiving day** through the following Saturday, we partnered with other institutions to distribute an **additional (combined) 4800 meals in downtown Los Angeles.**

In 2016 we partnered with La Placita to provide food for **800 people the 2nd and 4th Friday of the month. (Approximately 19,000 meals)**

**250 new tennis shoes** were donated to Casa Del Migrante in Tijuana. The Lay Scalabrinians contributed \$1,300 for the start up of a new food program for migrants on the move in Sonora Mexico.

**Three people involved in the outreach program have completed CLINIC's immigration training and are pursuing BIA accreditation. We also regularly update parishioners regarding immigration issues and rights.**
