

# ST. PETER & SAN CONRADO MISSION SCALABRINI OUTREACH ANNUAL PROGRAM SUMMARY OF SERVICES 2017

*The mission of St. Peter's/San Conrado Scalabrini Outreach Program is to see and embrace Christ coming to us in the poor; to promote and restore the dignity and rights of the migrant, homeless and economically vulnerable families.*

During 2017 we provided 42,550 meals, 9000 hygiene kits, served 2640 families through the food pantry and provided humanitarian relief to Texas and Puerto Rico.

In 2017 we partnered with the **Order of Malta** to produce **750 personal hygiene kits per month**. These are distributed to Los Angeles shelters for the homeless. Kits are assembled the second Tuesday of the month at 3:00 p.m.

**12,600 meals** were distributed to small missions in downtown Los Angeles, La Placita food program, Orange and Ventura Counties.

The Scalabrini **Food bank** was open the 1st & 3rd Friday of each month and served an **average of 220 families per month**. The families served are English, Spanish and Asian speaking families. Our thanks to St. Bridget's Church who assist with translation.

We provided **5,000 meals and assistance to Day Labor programs** for migrants in search of work at various Home Depots and Temporary Protected Status trainings in the Los Angeles area.

**18,000+- meals** were prepared the last Saturday of the month for distribution in **Skid row and homeless encampments**.

**200 blankets** were distributed to people living on the streets of Downtown LA and the La Placita area during **cold weather**.

**More than 1500 meals and 450 baskets** were distributed at our **Thanksgiving celebration**.

**450 meals** were prepared to assist with **Our Lady of the Holy Rosary's Day Labor Thanksgiving celebration**.

**Thanksgiving day** through the following Saturday, we partnered with other institutions to distribute an **additional (combined) 5000 meals in downtown Los Angeles**.

Scalabrini Outreach with support of Lay Scalabrinians, societies, polenta dinner, Sunday brunch & generous contributors, donated **hurricane relief supplies** to a Scalabrinian parish in Texas & relief in rural Puerto Rico. \$1500 was contributed to the Indian School in Mexican Huichol Siena State for **new school supplies**.

We regularly update parishioners regarding migrant and refugee rights and host training on migration issues.
