ST. PETER & SAN CONRADO MISSION LAY SCALABRINI OUTREACH ANNUAL PROGRAM SUMMARY OF SERVICES 2019

The mission of St. Peter's/San Conrado Scalabrini Outreach Program is to see and embrace Christ coming to us in the poor; to promote and restore the dignity and rights of the migrant, homeless and economically vulnerable families.

During 2019 we provided 69,042 meals, 8640 hygiene kits, and served 2,475 families through the food pantry.

We continued to partner with the **Order of Malta** to produce **720 personal hygiene kits per month.** These are distributed to Los Angeles shelters for the homeless and the Casa Migrante shelter for migrants in Tijuana, MX. Kits are assembled the second Tuesday of the month at 2:00 p.m.

26,300 meals were distributed to small missions in downtown Los Angeles, La Placita food program, Orange and Ventura Counties.

The Scalabrini **Food bank** was open the 2nd Friday of each month and served an **average of 220 families per month.** The families served are English, Spanish and Asian speaking families.

We provided **2,500** meals **and assistance to Day Labor programs** for migrants in search of work at various Home Depots.

5,400 + meals were prepared the last Saturday of the month for distribution in Skid row and homeless encampments.

224 blankets were distributed to people living on the streets of Downtown LA and the La Placita area during cold weather.

More than 1500 meals and 450 baskets were distributed at our Thanksgiving celebration.

400 meals were prepared to assist with Our Lady of the Holy Rosary's Day Labor Thanksgiving celebration.

Thanksgiving Day through the following Saturday, we partnered with other institutions to distribute an additional (combined) 5000 meals in downtown Los Angeles.

12,197 Meals were provided to assist Sacred Heart Church food pantry.

15695 Meals were provided for domestic violence families without work.

NEW IN 2020: Thanks to an expanded partnership with the Order of Malta, the **food pantry** will also provide approximately 5000 pounds of **fresh fruits and vegetables** each month.
