

That's right! The Crystal Coast has 1 Beautiful LightHouse located at Cape LookOut.

Did you know Cape Lookout National Seashore offers 56 miles of undeveloped beach sand! It's true!

During certain times of the year, you can actually climb to the top of the lighthouse to witness the absolutely breath-taking view.

Shackleford Banks and the many other islands and sandbars along the Crystal Coast are exciting to visit, too!

These islands are accessible by private boat. Or, contact a ferry or local tour company like one of my favorites, the LookOut Cruise, to take you!

That's right! The Crystal Coast has <u>2</u> piers remaining.

Oceana & Bogue Inlet are both popular destinations. Both offer restaurants, beach parking, restrooms, and fishing access/supplies in addition to other amenities.
