CPREG - Net Control Script

The CPREG Net is held every Wednesday night at 8:00 PM on one of the WY7SHR club repeaters:

- VHF/2m @ 147.855. Transmit on 147.255 with a tone of 100Hz.
- UHF/70cm @ 449.8 Hz. Transmit on 444.8 Hz with a tone of 100Hz.
- 1. QST, QST, QST. This is <CALL> the net control station. My name is <NAME> and I am opening the Cloud Peak Radio & Electronics Group net. This net is held every WEDNESDAY at 8:00 PM on the WY7SHR repeater. All local hams in the area covered by this repeater are invited to check in and visitors are encouraged to participate. The first purpose of the net is to train for participating in a directed net. The second purpose is to have fun, encourage visitors to participate and members to socialize. <Break for traffic>
- 2. This is <CALL> net control. Is there anyone with an **emergency** or **priority** situation, or anyone operating **mobile**? <Respond to any emergency, priority, or mobile calls>
- 3. Hearing none, net control will now call the roll. Please respond with your call sign,<Break for check-ins>
- 4. Roll call is completed. This is <CALL> net control opening the net to any late members or visitors wishing to check in. Please identify with your call sign and location. <Break for calls>
- 5. Net control will now call the checked in stations for announcements, comments or questions for others checked in. <Re-call the list of those who are checked in>
- 6. This is <CALL> net control. Are there any late check-ins, any last minute questions, comments or announcements before I close the net? <Break for any last minute comments>
- 7. I will now close this session of the CPREG net at _____PM. Thanks to all of you for checking in this evening. This is <CALL> signing off and returning the repeater to normal amateur radio use.
