As long as the nail is flat-topped, the color choice is yours. I'm not the best at hammering nails evenly and straight, so I use needle-nose pliers to hold the nail in place, which works every time. Plus, they enable you to hammer nails safely without injuring your string and tie it to the first nail, leaving a tail for tying off when you're using embroidery floss, use all six threads to avoid breakages when the string is pulled taut.
