



The Rhine, Main, and Moselle rivers **offer a magical tour of Germany's history and cultural elegance**. The best way to take in the captivating beauty of the vintage German towns, historic castles, and elegant vineyards is through an amazing river cruise.



One of Switzerland's most cosmopolitan cities, Basel is home to 40 museums (the highest concentration in the nation), a picturesque Old Town and richly decorated Market Square, a 500-year-old Rathaus (town hall), Switzerland's oldest zoo (built in 1870 and home to 600 animal species and exotic flora), and a variety of small boutiques offering treasured souvenirs.

-Embark on your journey along the Rhine...



BREISACH, GERMANY



Breisach is your gateway to several different excursions, depending on your interests.

-Step back in time with a visit to the enchanting Alsatian town of Colmar, which looks almost the same as it did in the 16th century.
-On your walking tour, admire historic architecture and perhaps get a glimpse of the Statue of Liberty, a small replica of the famous version in New York, to commemorate the sculptor's Colmar birthplace.

-Those wishing a more active excursion can cycle through the scenic countryside, or go on a hike to the Black Forest, a magical land full of cultural traditions.

STRASBOURG, FRANCE





The capital of Alsace, Strasbourg is beloved for its wine culture and its immense Cathedrale de Notre Dame – the world's fourth tallest church and an excellent example of 15th-century Gothic architecture. The city has changed hands between France and Germany multiple times throughout history and its unique heritage is evident throughout the city in terms of architecture, cuisine and more.

Discover Strasbourg's quaint 'Petite-France,' a small area of medieval half-timbered houses and Baroque sandstone buildings located on the Grande Ile (Main Island), where the river is split into a number of cascading canals.



Perched along the Neckar River, the university town of Heidelberg is known for its historic role in German Romanticism.

-Your clients may retrace the footsteps of great thinkers while hiking the Philosopher's Path

-Go on a walking tour that includes the historic red sandstone remains of Heidelberg Castle with its 220,000 liter Great Vat of wine

-Enjoy you free time (suggestion: go shopping in town in search of the Heidelberg Student's Kiss chocolate!)



RÜDESHEIM, GERMANY



In Rudesheim we offer a Gondola & wine tasting tour

-Enjoy a peaceful ride over the vineyards on Rüdesheim's gondola. Once you have arrived up top, you will have free time to explore and see the Niederwalddenkmal – a monument inaugurated in 1883 to represent the union of all Germans. Enjoy gorgeous views of the vineyard, the town and the beautiful Rhine Valley.

-Afterwards, we invite you to enjoy a wine tasting at the Bassenheimer Hof - you will sample their specialty Riesling wines.

-Guests may also opt to hike through the vineyards, taste Rüdesheim's world-famous coffee, set aflame with whipped cream and coffee, or enter the whimsical world of Siegfried's Mechanical Musical Instrument Museum.



Cruise through the picturesque UNESCO-designated Rhine Gorge or Upper Middle Rhine Valley, admiring its 40+ castles and fortress ruins. You'll also pass by the legendary Lorelei Rock, where, it is said, a beautiful woman lures sailors with her enchanting song. To this day, a number of shipwrecks have been attributed to the legend of Lorelei. Up on the Sun Deck, you can hear the commentary from our Cruise Manager with stories and legends behind many of these castles.



DÜSSELDORF, GERMANY



Starting in 2024 on our Enchanting Rhine and Captivating Rhine itineraries, we will be docking across the river in Dusseldorf
-Düsseldorf sits on both sides of the Rhine with the Old Town on one side and the more modern side on the other
-We visit the old town, and see the Art Academy, the Castle Tower, and the "longest bar in the world" – actually 260 bars – On the tour we taste
the amber Altbier that has a strong rivalry with Colognes Kolsch beer.

-There will also be excursion option to Cologne from Dusseldorf (about a 45 min drive)



COLOGNE, GERMANY



Cologne is Germany's 4th largest city founded by the Romans and known for it famous cathedral whose twin spires dominate the skyline.

-Guests will have a chance to visit the stunning 13th-century Cologne Cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the second tallest structure in the city (533 stairs to the top!), which survived bombings during World War II. On our tour we stroll through the Old Town where you will see such sites as the Cologne Rathaus, Germany's oldest town hall; the Fishmarkt, which dates back to the 12th century and the Great St. Martin Church.

-Alternative excursions include a bike tour through Cologne -OR tasting Kölsch beer within sight of the cathedral.



Amsterdam features a labyrinthine network of over 165 manmade canals upon which AmaWaterways guests may choose an included canal cruise. A UNESCO World Heritage Site, it also features 1,281 bridges; 1,550 so-called "monumental buildings"; 2,500 houseboats and miles of colorful, quaint cobblestone streets.
