RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- 1. Outside books/comics/magazines CDs, DVDs, Mobile Phone should not be brought to school. Any confiscated articles shall not be given back.
- 2. Chewing of pan, gutka, tobacco products; used of alcohol, drugs are prohibited. Failure to respect this regulation may result in suspension/expulsion.
- 3. Use of ornaments with school uniform is not acceptable, e.g. earrings, ear-studs, necklace, hairclips, rings etc.
- 4. Colour dyed hair, imitating current hair style in shape or length is not acceptable.
- 5. Doodling or scribbling on desk is strictly forbidden. Students should refrain from this kind of bad habits.
- 6. Pupils should show respect and behave obediently to teachers and other staff members. Use of vulgar languages and noisy behaviors are not allowed.
- 7. Pupils must treat school property with care and keep the class-rooms and school environment clean.
- 8. No bill are issued therefore parents should see that fees are paid in advance each month. A late fine of `50 will be levied for the delay.

- The rank and division of a successful candidate is decided on the basis of best 5 (five) subjects which is subject to having passed the compulsory subjects.
- In case of a tie in the marks, the grades of the internally assessed subjects are taken into consideration for deciding the ranks.
- Ranks in order of merit and citation certificates are given only when the topper secure 70% or more in their aggregate.

TEXT BOOKS/UNIFORMS:

A list of required text books will be given for the students to buy from book shops. Details, with regards to uniform will be specified at the time of admission.

VITAL INFORMATION:

- 1. Students are advised to choose the elective and optional subjects keeping in view their future course of higher studies.
- 2. Class 11 students will be given a Registration Card by the NBSE. through the school for their eligibility to sit at the board's examinations
- 3. No students shall be allowed to change his/her subject(s) after passing class 11
- 4. Change of stream is allowed only for the failed candidates of class 11 after getting prior permission from the NBSE.
- 5. A student must have a minimum attendance of 80% in order to sit for promotion/final examination.
- 6. Result of students will be determined by taking into account the secured marks in class tests, midterm exams, and internal assessment grading and promotion or selection exam.
- 7. The school hours are from 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. every day except Saturday. School hours for 1st and 3rd Saturday are from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.
- 8. Students must reach the school by 8:50 am sharp. Attendance will be taken every period.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

- 1. Students who have secured above 45% marks in both Science and Mathematics can take admission directly.
- 2. The consolidated annual fees such as Admission, Establishment, Laboratory, Examination, Library, Sports & Games, Registration, Caution, Contingency and tuition fee for May amounting to
 - `17,000 /- (Rupees Seventeen thousand only). Monthly tuition fee is `1500 /- (one thousand five hundred only)
