The Citrus County Veterans Coalition food pantry provides food for veterans and their families. The food pantry is open from 9 a.m. to noon on Tuesdays and the first and third Thursdays (excluding holidays). The pantry is located at 1081 North Paul St. in Inverness. The pantry offers a variety of dry, canned, and frozen for veterans in need. For food assistance, call 352-400-8952 or ask a volunteer during food pantry hours.

According to the coalition officers, the demand has increased for their services and support. They are seeing an increase of widows of veterans asking for assistance for basic food items.

The Citrus County Veterans Coalition has an immediate need for a replacement in ground commercial water pump and well. The cost for the replacement is estimated at \$13,000.

SEWING FOR VETERANS



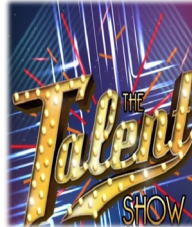
