ENF AND THE HARRY ANNA TRUST FUND

ENF stands for Elks National Foundation. All the lodges in the country send money to the Elks National Foundation but did you know that for every dollar that is sent to the Fund the Grand Lodge gives back about two and a half dollars to our lodge? When you purchase a 50/50 ticket one half of the proceeds go to ENF. The fund is safely invested to return enough to fund grants for things like veteran's services, children's services and a host of other community investments.

The Harry Anna Trust Fund is a fund set up, primarily, in the same way as the ENF. The trust fund, started in 1951, was named after Harry and Anna Miller who donated land and a building to establish the original Florida Elks Hospital for Crippled Children. Its purpose was, and continues to be, the collection of donations and the acceptance of endowed gifts. The trust fund is restricted, which means that only the income derived from it may be used to support our major projects: the Florida Elks Children's Therapy Services and Florida Elks Youth Camp programs. You can donate to Harry Anna by filling a quarter tube in the lounge or by a bequest to the lodge.

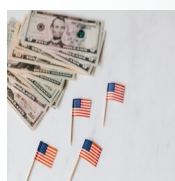
BINGO NEWS

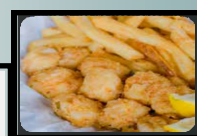

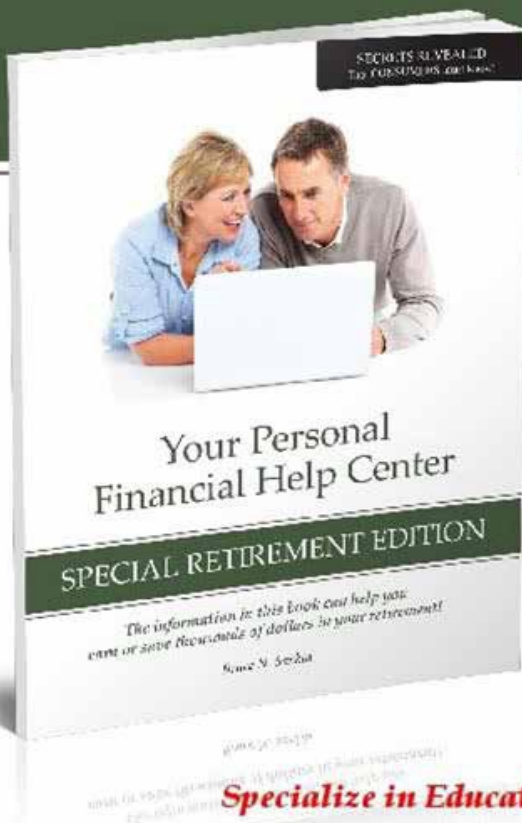
