The Words of Institution

We give thanks to God the Father that our Savior, Jesus Christ, before he suffered, gave us this memorial of his sacrifice, until he comes again. At his last supper, the Lord Jesus took bread, and when he had given

thanks, he broke it and said, “This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me.” In the same way, he took the cup after supper and said, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this in remembrance of me.” For whenever we eat this bread and drink this cup, we proclaim the Lord’s death until he comes (*1 Corinthians 11:23-26*). By faith, the ancient Church proclaimed, “Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again.” By the power of the Holy Spirit, let us make the confession our own. Let us say to the risen Christ: (*All say*)

You, O Christ, have died for me.

You are risen from the dead.

You are with me always.

When I go to you,

or you come again to earth,

I will see you.
