Bonnie Update: (*Written December 23*) About a month ago my cancer marker numbers jumped way up. Fearing I had moved to stage 4, the doctor drained 7.5 liters drained from around my liver. The following week my doctor was surprised to tell me the fluid was normal--no cancer found. He prescribed an MRI and liver biopsy. Today the MRI results showed no cancer. So **Please Praise The Lord** with me and for me. What another wonderful Christmas miracle gift God has given me. (*Written January 7*) Well, we go from the mountain top to the low valley. But no matter where we are, God is with us. We met with my oncologist this morning and learned that the Tumor Board agreed that due to my increasing cancer marker numbers, my cancer is back. They believe it is in the "bed" where the pancreas laid. I will not have more chemo; I will have a stint put into my Portal Vein to help drain the liver. **Pray for peace for both of us, and relief from pain.** We cannot thank y'all enough for holding us up in prayer. God is my refuge and my strength! I cling to that.
