Lent is a time for reflection on the Passion of Christ as well as a time to reflect on our own lives. Lent began Sunday, February 17 and ends on Sunday, April 4 – EASTER! During Lent there will be a **display in front of church** to help us visualize the Passion of our Lord in a tangible and intimate way.

Each week the display will have elements added to it depicting those last days of our Lord and Savior. It begins with the 2 beams that made up the cross on which Jesus was crucified and will end with a glorious empty cross – reminding us that Jesus suffered and died for us but did not stay dead! "He is not here! He has risen!" Matthew 28:6

This week's verse is Isaiah 53:4-5:

Surely he took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows, yet we considered him stricken by God, smitten by him and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed.
