- ◇ Congregational meeting June 17 at 7 pm.



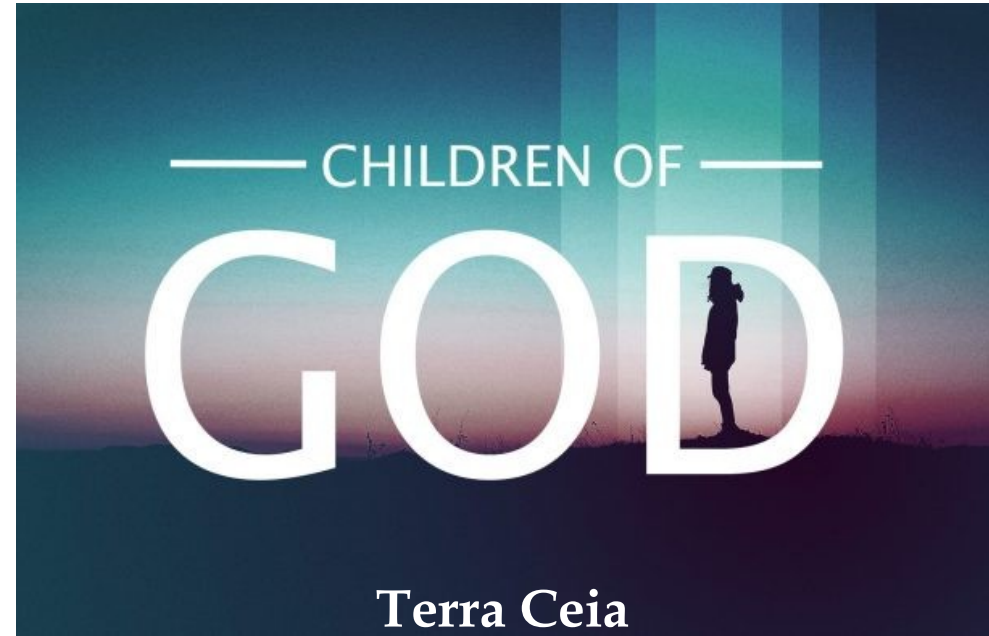
