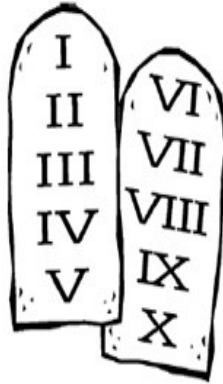


The Greatest Commandment

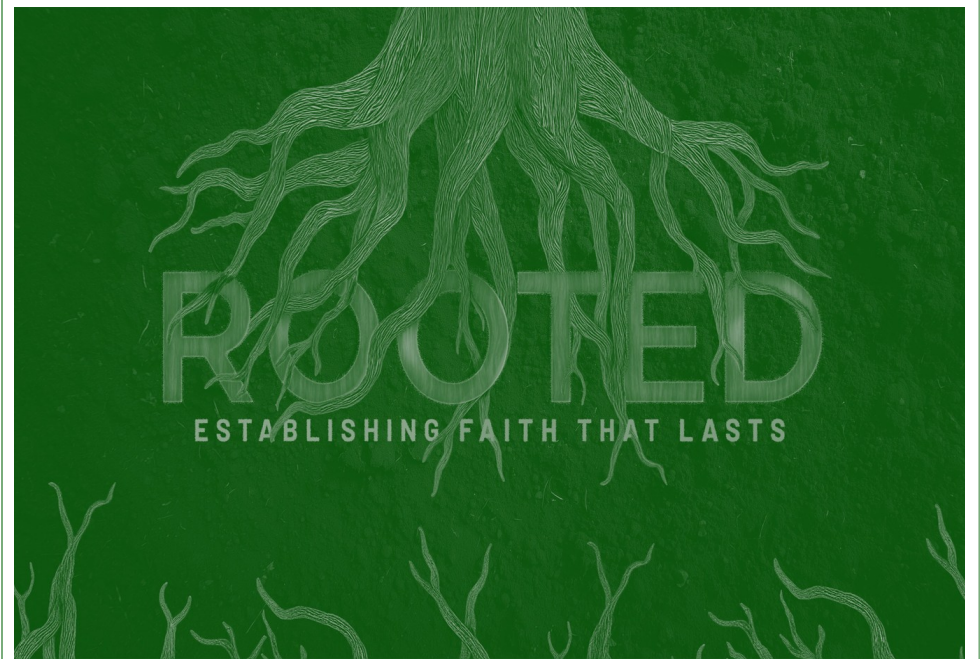
