After graduating from Trinity Christian College and Westminster Seminary he met Ruth in Grand Rapids, MI while studying for one year at Calvin Seminary.

Ruth, who is a first cousin of Jan DeHoog, was born in New Jersey and also went to Trinity. She was working as a copy editor at the CRC Board of Publications when we met in 1982.
