Journey through the Night is a novel for youth and adults, originally in four volumes published from 1951 to 1958, by Dutch author Anne de Vries. The novel centers around the representation of World War II in the Netherlands and the impact it had on a reformed family. The story is divided into 4 parts:

- 1. Into the Darkness
- 2. The Darkness Deepens
- 3. Dawn's Early Light
- 4. A New Day

The main character is Jan, the eldest son of the de Boer family. During World War II, the 5-year German occupation, he gets involved in the Resistance.

A new 3-book set is real-life based by Dirk van Leenen, a boy living in Europe during World War II. Van Leenen got the details from his dad, an active Resistance member at the time.

- 1. *Resistance on a Bicycle*, the starting point of this top-selling book trilogy
- 2. *The Americans Are Coming*, the last hope to win the war in Holland
- 3. The Last Train to the Concentration Camp, a small boy's memories on the train to Bergen Belsen
