Today's Message: "Who Do You Say that I Am?"

Luke 9:18-36 – The greatest question anyone could ever ask is "Who is Jesus?" How we answer this question shapes how we live out the implications to this question. If we answer that Jesus is the Christ, like Peter did, then we also need to know we followed a crucified Christ. To follow a crucified Christ is to consider ourselves dead to corrupt dynamics of the world and alive to the new creation dynamics of God's kingdom.

- In what areas of your life are you living in the old dynamics of a crucified world rather than the new dynamics of resurrection life?
