### Dear Terra Ceia CRC,

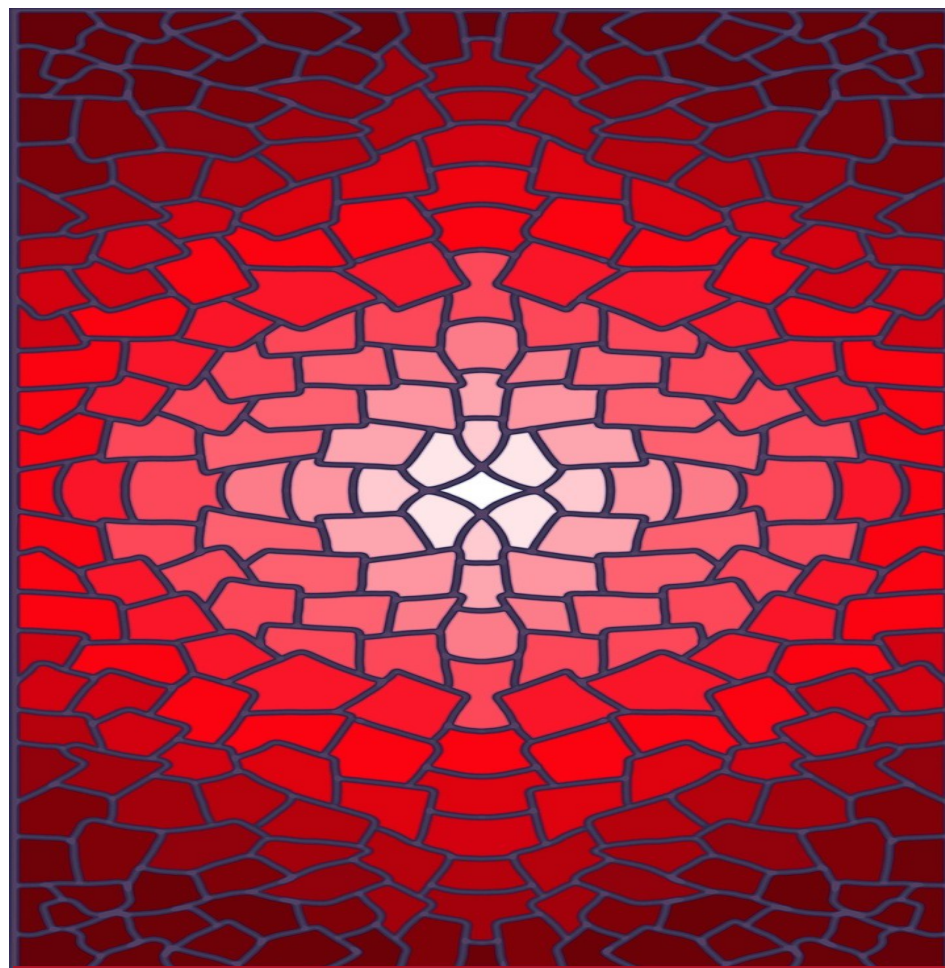
