“I’m a little disappointed. I was looking forward to having a Plan C. You presented at the planning commission and heard from about 22 people, I know staff has likely given you feedback over the past couple weeks,” said Councilor Elise Ryan. “I know that there is an Option C out there, my concern is we are being presented tonight with making a decision on whether it’s Option A or Option B, and I don’t think that’s really the choice that we should be asked to make. I don’t think either one of them are concepts I could comfortably move forward with.”

Councilor Elise Ryan said that while excited about the trail around the lake, she is concerned about density, and eliminating the open space along Galpin Boulevard.

“That scares people and changes the look and feel of that area,” Ryan said. Residents are afraid of trees being clear-cut and houses stacked on top of each other, Ryan said. “Just pay attention to zoning and lot sizes.”
