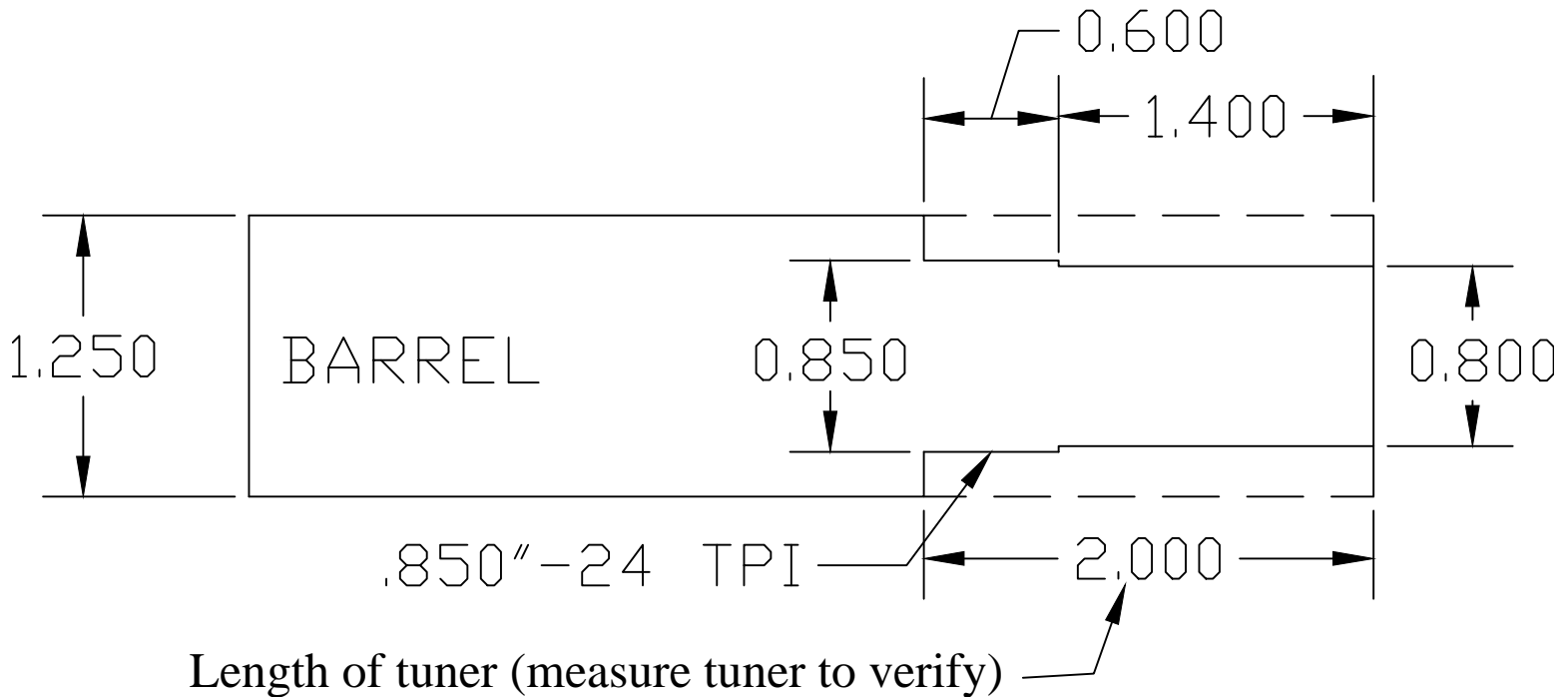


Erik Cortina's "ECtuner" installation instructions.

- Tuner and muzzle should be flush, make adjustments if necessary.
- Fit tuner with set screws removed.
- Thread to a class 3 thread fit.
- Apply anti-seize to tuner for fitting.
- From shooter perspective, make a mark on barrel at 9:00 o'clock for right handed shooter and 3:00 o'clock for left handed shooter. Index tuner's 0 to that mark when tight against shoulder.
- Set tuner against shoulder and tighten friction screws. Tuner should turn by hand but not on it's own. I prefer screws on the tight side.

HOW TO FIND BEST ACCURACY WITH TUNER

1. With tuner on 0, find powder charge node where ES is low and stable.
2. Adjust seating depth for best accuracy.
3. Shoot groups on tuner setting 0, 2, 4, etc. If groups look good at setting #8 and #10, set tuner at setting #9.
4. Tuner should not need to be moved after this. Notice which way the groups are flat. If you encounter vertical during a match, turn tuner one mark towards flat.
