#### **HELPFUL NOTES**

- 1. Many Speakers today require booking well in advance and WIs are advised to plan their programmes at least six months ahead. When booking Speakers please check with them, fees and travelling expenses, in case they have changed since publication.
- 2. Remember when booking Speakers to:
  - Give subject of lecture and time allocated for them to speak
  - State Date, Time, Day and Place of meeting
  - State approximate number expected in audience
  - Contact ALL Speakers in good time, including WIAs and County Sub-committee Members
- 3. Telephone bookings should **ALWAYS** be confirmed in email/writing and copies kept.
- **4.** Ready-printed forms to Speakers are available from WI House or at the back of this brochure.
- 5. Reminders to Speakers should be sent at least two weeks before your meeting and most Speakers appreciate clear directions to your Hall. Parking facilities for your Speaker near to the door of the Hall are also appreciated.
- **6.** Please ensure mobile contact details are exchanged with Speaker in case of emergency / last minute changes.
- 7. The Federation would be pleased to have suggestions for additions to the panel of Speakers and would welcome favourable comments.
- **8.** In the event of a WI needing to make a complaint against a speaker that is listed in the brochure, please submit complaint details to WI House whereupon the matter will be investigated. The Federation will remove a speaker if after investigation there has been three separate complaints made.
