DISSOLUTION OF THE TE-MOAK HOUSING BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA, THAT

WHEREAS, this organization is an Indian Organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934, as amended, to exercise certain rights and to be responsible for the promotion of the economic, health and welfare of its members; and

WHEREAS, the Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone Tribal Council ("Council") is composed of Constituent Bands known as the Battle Mountain Band Council, Elko Band Council, South Fork Band Council and Wells Band Council ("Bands"); and

WHEREAS, ARTICLE 4, Sec. 3, <u>Powers of the Tribal Council</u>. (e) To charter and regulate independent organizations, subordinate organizations, committees, and boards of officials of the Tribe; and to delegate powers as appropriate, retaining the right to supervise and to rescind delegated powers;...;and

WHEREAS, the Te-Moak Housing Board of Commissioners has been negligent in the purposes as outlined in Ordinance No. V(76-01), 2. Alleviating the acute shortage of decent, safe and sanitary dwellings for persons of low income; and

WHEREAS, the Te-Moak Housing Board of Commissioners has not been successful in obtaining funding under Ordinance No. V(76-01) to address 1, That there exists within the area of the jurisdiction of this Council insanitary, unsafe and overcrowded dwelling accommodations; that there is a shortage of decent, safe and sanitary dwelling accommodations available at rents or prices which persons of low income can afford, and that such shortage forces such persons to occupy insanitary, unsafe and overcrowded dwelling accommodations; and

WHEREAS, the Te-Moak Housing Board of Commissioners has not reported any of the expenditures from the CARES/ARPA funding as to amount and distribution; and


WHEREAS, The Te-Moak Housing Authority has purportedly issued a quitclaim deed on the Tribal Administration building, located at 525 Sunset St. Elko, Nevada 89801;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Te-Moak Tribal Council hereby dissolves the Te-Moak Housing Board of Commissioners and will in the interim serve as the Board of Commissioners for the Te-Moak Housing Authority until new commissioners are selected and seated pursuant to tribal law;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any and all resolutions appointing any of the Commissioners to the Te-Moak Housing Board are hereby rescinded.

CERTIFICATION
