3-4 & Grade K-1 COMBINATION CLASSES: These classes will focus on the basic skills in ballet and tap. Dancers attend **ONE** class so pick the one that works best in your schedule. They will perform in our winter showcase and spring recital.

Grade 2-3 & 4-6 COMBINATION CLASSES: Dancers will work on basic skills in the styles listed by their class. They will perform in our winter showcase and spring recital. If a class fills up we will add another section.

Grade 7-12 COMBINATION CLASSES: This class will offer dancers a variety of styles of dance. They will work on different styles each week and pick what style they want to perform in the annual shows.

POINTE: This class will need teacher approval and dancer must be in a ballet class as well.

HIP HOP: Hip hop is a style of dance that is fun and upbeat. This style will incorporate breaking, isolations, and popping. Dancers will learn different dance combinations and perform 1 dance in our winter showcase and spring recital.

TAP: Dancers will work on different tap skills to work on rhythm and percussion. There are many different styles of tap dance such as Broadway and classical that dancers will work on. They will perform 1 dance in our winter showcase and spring recital.

CONTEMPORARY: This style of dance will be a combination of modern and ballet class. Dancers will learn about improv and continue to work on combinations throughout the year. They will perform 1 dance in our winter showcase and spring recital.

ACRO: Students will work on different acrobatic skills. This class is just for technique and does **NOT** perform in our winter showcase or spring recital.
