#### **SATURDAY**

\*For ages 3-4 and grade K-3 combination classes please pick one class to attend for the week. Dancers will learn basic skills in the styles of dance listed.

\*All dancers in grades 7-12 will be split into two levels of dancers.

**COMBINATION CLASSES:** These classes will focus on the basic skills listed. Dancers should pick one class time that works for them for the combination classes. These classes will perform 2 dances in our winter showcase and our spring recital. Each class will need 1 costume for their spring recital performance.

**POINTE:** This class will need teacher approval and dancer must be in a ballet class as well.

**HIP HOP:** Hip hop is a style of dance that is fun and upbeat. This style will incorporate breaking, isolations, and popping. Dancers will learn different dance combinations and perform 1 dance in our winter showcase and spring recital.

**TAP:** Dancers will work on different tap skills to work on rhythm and percussion. There are many different styles of tap dance such as Broadway and classical that dancers will work on. They will perform 1 dance in our winter showcase and spring recital.

**CONTEMPORARY:** This style of dance will be a combination of modern and ballet class. Dancers will learn about improv and continue to work on combinations throughout the year. They will perform 1 dance in our winter showcase and spring recital.

**ACRO/LEAPS & TURNS:** Students will work on different acrobatic skills as well as basic to advanced leaps and turns. This class is just for technique and does NOT perform in our winter showcase or spring recital.
