Winter Field Day Log is attach and here is an update;

Worked 51 different stations – We did not run this as a contest but as a fun activity to allow different members to have time at the mic. We had many great conversations and the radios just set with no op.

Worked 32 different sections plus a few DX contacts. They were Brazil, Cuba, Costa Rica, Alberta and Hawaii. Tried real hard to work a station in Spain, but we could not break the pile up.

Used 2 Bands 20 & 40 Meters – 160 was the pits, only two QSO going on and no one working Winter Field Day.

Antennas (Bands) installed – primarily by Mike W5EVT.

- 5BTV 80/10 was excellent being on the large metal roof. Which I had a metal roof.
- -160 meter dipole work as it should, but too much work for what activity there is on that band for Winter Field Day.
- Mikes W5EVT new to him Buddie Pole set it up for 20 meters, work awesome made contact to RI, then took down to use mast for another antenna.
- DCARC gave LARS s Go Kit which included a Cobra JR. Tri-Folded Dipole feed with Ladder Line Feed Line and a 4:1 Balun. This antennas is good they say from 80 through 10 meters using internal antenna tuner of your radio. So using Mike's Buddie Pole mast with install this antenna and made a few contacts on 20 meters. It would not tune on 40, not sure why.
- DCARC also included in the Go Kit an Arrow J-Pole which we installed 3' off the ground on a BBQ Grill. It work both the 17 & 92 repeaters full quieting.

Radio Station #1 consisted of the Clubs Yasue FT-950 and power supply
Radio Station #2 consisted of the newly acquired from DCARC an ICOM 718 for HF and
Kenwood A700 VHF/UHF and power supply.

We had five different operators at the mic or CW key. They were Steve W5JK, Clark K5LGX, Perry NE5ET, Roger AE5EZ and Jim WB8YWA. Hope I didn't overlook anyone.

We had 11 members and two stay for the complete 24 hours 9 Mike W5EVT & Jim WB8YWA.

We had five non hams visit us.


