
BOAT LAUNCH PROTOCOL

- Have your vessel ready to launch before getting to the ramp area. Launch your vessel and clear the ramp area. Do not block the ramp area.
- No boat clean-up or swimming in the ramp area.
- If your vessel will not start, clear the ramp area.
- Vessels are not allowed in the swimming area and must observe the No Wake rules, particularly in the boat-launch area. Vessels are not allowed to tie up in the boat-launch area.
- Stop the spread of invasive species. CLEAN, DRAIN and DRY your boat.

- POTA is a “two-for-one” when it comes to Club Operations: W5LVC AND YOU, both, receive credit for a successful activation (more than 10 QSO’s)


