ARRL Field Day, June 24 & 25

Technical Director's Corner

Controlling the receive audio for your station

My station consists of two HF/6 radios, one HF/VHF/UHF radio, VHF 220 MHz FM radio and my VHF/UHF FM radio. Believe it or not when I am in the shack there are times I have most of them on listening. I monitor 50 MHz, 144 MHz and now starting to monitor 432 weak signal SSB on three of my rigs. Then monitor our two repeaters 145.170 and 224.08. That is a total of five rigs on at the same time.

I have my shack in a five foot bi-fold door closet and must keep space under control. I also enjoy simple operating techniques and use my computer with ham radio all the time. It is my logging system, my maps (world, grid, and zones), my digital modes (PSK and RTTY). For these last two modes to connect radio to computer takes an audio interface and two audio cables where mic of radio goes to audio out of computer and mic of computer goes to audio in of radio. That is only one problem with cables and equipment in the shack. Then if you want to switch radios for your digital modes, add the separate speaker for each radio and the separate mic. This all takes a lot of room and gets very confusing. It is also nice to have computer speakers, plus I want to use my iPhone and iPad connecting them to external speakers when watching You Tube ham radio videos. You can see where I am going with this. A lot of cables and reconnecting and time to do all this. Here is one method I have used to solve these problems and at the same time made operating my station a whole lot easier.

To solve the radio mic problem, I purchased a Heil ICM boom mic with foot switch. I wanted hands free so I could use the computer for logging, QRZ and other things while transmitting. Once I had the boom mic, I wanted to be able to use it for all my radios. So I built a mic switch that allowed me to throw one switch to use the boom mic on three of my radios. See Oct 2016 Newsletter for that article.

To solve the other side of the audio (receive of the radios) I purchased a Behringer Q802USB Audio Mixer for around \$59 from Amazon. This device gives you a lot of things in one small box.

- 1) USB interface to computer. Sound card interface at punch of one button.
- 2) Connection of audio out to BOSE WAVE radio I already owned. Can be any audio amp and speakers.
 - a. Radios (4)
 - b. iPhone / IPad
 - c. Computer speakers no switching or hooking up and anything. Just adjust a knob or push a button switch.
 - d. Connection to Rig Blaster receive audio for digital modes
- 3) Headset connected to all devices, radios, computer, iPhone, and iPad without switching anything.
- 4) Push of a button and flip of a switch and you have all digital modes to all radios. That simple.


Below is a picture of my station where you can see the mixer and stereo. The mixer is very easy to operate and needs to be placed so you can get to the controls. You will find that you will be adjusting the mixer and not the radio receive audio. Each radio has its own equalizer and volume control, plus you have a master volume control for output to the amplifier and one for your headset. One more benefit, with the equalizer you can adjust audio tone on HF to help in pulling out weak SSB/CW signals when band has high noise floor.



Just in front of mixer is a homebrew mic switch. Need to look close but Bose Wave is between rotor control and my homebrew Amp Standby Switch. Speaker on top of scope is not used. Can switch it into the mixer but never do, sound from Bose is outstanding so I use it for everything.

The only cables I now have to swap is my CW Bencher, which on the ICOM's is front mounted jack. I can connect loose cable from mixer to either my iPhone or iPad if I want to use them with my amp.

Below is a hand drawing of connection to the Behringer Q802USB. It does not have to be a Behringer or a BOSE. It can be any mixer and any stereo amp. With the Bose, I have left and right speaker control from mixer so one radio can be fed to left speaker and another to right. Or I can mix to both.



I now have my Rigblaster connected between the output of the Behringer and Bose right speaker. This gives me the ability to use this device with all the radios also. This set up has proven to be well worth the effort of obtaining the equipment and time spent setting it up.
