



## Room Set-up Information for Trumping the Race Card Book Signing Experience

The Trumping the Race Card Experience serves as a way to introduce key individuals, as well as departments and the entire campus and surrounding community to the book; Trumping the Race Card. Rodney Patterson endeavors to visit several colleges and universities over the next several weeks offering an experience, **free** for each participating campus. The plan for the session would include identifying a person on campus to conduct a brief 20-30 minute, live interview with Mr. Patterson, before invited guest across campus and the surrounding community. Following the interview, the audience can engage in a question/answer period, facilitated by the interviewer. Upon completion of the experience, Mr. Patterson will remain on site to sign books purchased by those attending the event.

There are four main components for the room set-up to accommodate the interview format of the TTRC Book Signing Experience.

- 1. INTERVIEW:** Mr. Patterson requests a set-up at the front of the room where the interview can be held.
  - a. Two chairs
  - b. A small table between them is preferred
  - c. Microphone(s)
- 2. SEATING:** Any number of seating arrangements work for the TTRC Book Signing Experience. Classroom, Chevron, Auditorium. The important thing is that everyone is facing the front. If round tables are used, Mr. Patterson prefers that people are seated on half – so everyone at the table is comfortably facing forward.
- 3. SALES:** One or two tables (4 or 6 ft. long) needed at the back of the room to accommodate book sales.
- 4. SIGNING:** One table will be required for Mr. Patterson to conduct the book signing following the interview portion of the event.
