Take away # 1

Take away #2

Accepting Jesus' substitutional death on the cross, frees us from the power of sin and death.

John 2:19-21 Jesus answered and said to them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." ²⁰ Then the Jews said, "It has taken forty-six years to build this temple, and will You raise it up in three days?" ²¹ But He was speaking of the temple of His body.

Mark 8:31 And He began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things, and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again.

Mark 10:34 and they will mock Him, and ^[a]scourge Him, and spit on Him, and kill Him. And the third day He will rise again."

Take away #3

The resurrection validated the Scriptures, which foretold His coming and resurrection.

1Corinthians 15:13 - 18 But if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ is not risen. ¹⁴ And if Christ is not risen, then our preaching [is] empty and your faith [is] also empty. ¹⁵ Yes, and we are found false witnesses of God, because we have testified of God that He raised up Christ, whom He did not raise up--if in fact the dead do not rise. ¹⁶ For if [the] dead do not rise, then Christ is not risen. ¹⁷ And if Christ is not risen, your faith [is] futile; you are still in your sins! ¹⁸ Then also those who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished.

Take away #4

The resurrection was the supreme validation of His deity.
