Revelation 2: 1 - 2 "To the angel of the church of Ephesus write, 'These things says He who holds the seven stars in His right hand, who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands: "I know your works, your labor, your patience, and that you cannot bear those who are evil.

Pattern of the Letters

1. The message is addressed to the "angel" of that church. The "spirit" of that church.

- A reference to an aspect of Christ's visionary appearance.
- 3. Jesus acknowledges what they are doing right.
- A judgment or rebuke for what they are doing wrong.
- 5. The promised reward for obedience
- 6. A challenge to give their full attention.

Revelation 2:2 - 3 And you have tested those who say they are apostles and are not, and have found them liars; ³ and you have persevered and have patience, and have labored for My name's sake and have not become weary.

Revelation 2: 4 – 6 Nevertheless I have this against you, that you have left your first love. ⁵ Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent and do the first works, or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place—unless you repent. ⁶ But this you have, that you hate the deeds of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate.


Question # 2

Will I hear what He is saying?


