To the angel of the : angel = messenger spirit of the
church = US

Three sets of judgments during the tribulation: Seven
Seals, Seven Trumpets and Seven Bowls

The first four of the opened seals are known as the
Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse

John experienced a set of visions: The Throne of God
and The Throne of Christ and God Together

Revelation 4: 1-4 *After these things I looked, and behold, a
door standing open in heaven. And the first voice which I
heard was like a trumpet speaking with me, saying, “Come
up here, and I will show you things which must take place
after this.”* ² *Immediately I was in the Spirit; and behold, a
throne set in heaven, and One sat on the throne.* ³ *And He
who sat there was like a jasper and a sardius stone in
appearance; and there was a rainbow around the
throne, in appearance like an emerald.* ⁴ *Around the*

throne were twenty-four thrones, and on the thrones I saw twenty-four elders sitting, clothed in white robes; and they had crowns of gold on their heads.

Take away # 1 In order to understand the Apocalypse/Revelation given to John, we must understand the distinctiveness of the Christian faith - the Trinity.

**The Trinity = God the Father, God the Son
and God the Holy Spirit**

Revelation 4:5-8 *And from the throne proceeded lightnings, thunderings, and voices. Seven lamps of fire were burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God. ⁶ Before the throne there was a sea of glass, like crystal. And in the midst of the throne, and around the throne, were four living creatures full of eyes in front and in back. ⁷ The first living creature was like a lion, the second living creature like a calf, the third living creature had a face like a man, and the fourth living creature was like a flying eagle. ⁸ The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: "Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!"*

Lion = Wild Animals

Ox = Domesticated Animals

Man = Human intelligence

Flying Eagle = Birds of the air

Genesis 1:26 *Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."*

Isaiah 6: 1 – 8 *In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple. ² Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. ³ And one cried to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory!" ⁴ And the posts of the door were shaken by the voice of him who cried out, and the house was filled with smoke. ⁵ So I said: "Woe is me, for I am undone! Because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, The Lord of Hosts." ⁶ Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a live coal which he had taken with the tongs from the altar. ⁷ And he touched my mouth with it, and said: "Behold, this has touched your lips; your iniquity is taken away, and your sin purged." ⁸ Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying: "Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?" Then I said, "Here am I! Send me."*

Take away # 2

I understand that the four beings each represent an attribute of God that we are called to display by relying on the power of the Holy Spirit.
(Representing all of God's creation!!).

Revelation 4:9 - 11 *Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever, ¹⁰ the twenty-four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying: "You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created."*

Take away # 3

As God's children we need to praise and honor God with our thoughts, words and actions because He is the creator and sustainer of everything.
