The Pastor's Corner



From the Pastor's Desk:

For a church to thrive in these difficult and divisive times, each church must provide opportunities for attendees to experience an encounter with God's Holy Spirit. The season of Lent is the perfect opportunity for the local church to offer those opportunities.

Beginning with Ash Wednesday on March 5, and continuing though Easter Sunday, April 20th, we will be offering many activities that offer the possibility of participants encountering the Holy Spirit. The theme for this year's focus is, "In His Steps."

1. A five-week Bible study entitled "The Death and Resurrection of the Messiah" by Ray Vander Laan, will be offered beginning Wednesday, March 5th, from 6:30 to 7:30 p.m., in the Avenue J classroom. The lessons consist of a video and brief discussion.

The study will continue each Wednesday through April 9th. Being a follower of Jesus does not mean staying away from evil. It means confronting it - face to face- just like Jesus did every single day and through his resurrection. In this study, participants will learn how confronting evil can be loudly proclaiming the name of Jesus or quietly caring for someone in need!

- 2. We will be providing daily prayer journals so that each of the 40 days of Lent, beginning with Ash Wednesday, participants will be offered a scripture, a place to make a journal entry, and a prayer so that we can stay in the mode of prayer and repentance throughout the Lenten season.
- 3. Each Sunday, we will be encouraging participants to "be the hands and feet of Jesus" in the following week, and to write down on a small construction paper "foot" or "hand" what it is you did that week. Those will be posted (without names) on the bulletin board in the main hallway.
- 4. Special services will be held on Good Friday and Easter Sunday, so that we can experience both the darkness of a life without Jesus, and the utter joy of our lives with Jesus in them.
- 5. The older children will have the option of using either the adult prayer journals, or some special activity books for our younger children (or both!). The children's activity is called "Run and Tell!" and is about spreading the Good News of Jesus.

I am really excited about our entire church following "In His Steps" together during this Lenten season. Join me as we experience Jesus in new and wondrous ways.


Girl Scout Sunday

Easter Breakfast


