Trustees: Waiting for second estimate for termite damage for back of the building

Scheduling: yard sale March 14&15; March 22 birthday party; bridal shower March 29; Redbud festival is April 26

History: no history

Gooney Valley History and Preservation: Wind damage to steeple (blown from the roof last week) What is the longterm plan for the church? This is currently owned by the Browntown Baptist Church. Built in 1882; oldest building in Browntown. Community Center was built in 1907 by the same builder. Museum will be opened during the yard sale. Warren Heritage Society would like a presentation regarding Browntown history.

BEARR Group: Alan – burn law is in effect until 4.Red Flag day – fine is \$3500.

Ways and Means: Yard sale – one weekend; Redbud April 26: looking for bake sale items

Supervisor Cullers: South River forum was Feb 23 2025 at SHS and we had 68 people in attendance. Garbage loose on Browntown-Bentonville Road.
