JACKSON STOKES JAN 14 AT HEIST BREWERY & BARREL ARTS

Jackson Stokes is an original soul-rock singer-songwriter and road-dog from St. Louis, MO. Playing professionally for over half of his life, 30 y.o. Jackson has toured 4 different continents through his work as the guitarist of the Devon Allman Project, Tonina, and with his solo band. Stokes has co-written and played on multiple charting records including Devon Allman's *Ride or Die* which went #1 on the Billboard Blues Charts. Jackson's next record is being produced by Luther Dickinson and will be coming out in the Spring of 2023 on Create Records which includes his newest single, "*Gemini*". He has opened and shared the stage with numerous acts such as Robert Cray, Eric Gales, Lucas Nelson, Samantha Fish, Ivan Neville, Eric Krasno, The Allman Betts Band, and Robert Randolph. Guitar Player Magazine has said, "Jackson Stokes is charting his own path with a tour de force of soulful rhythm and blues guitar playing."

Blues Sunday: Hughes Taylor Band Feb 4, 2024

An old soul hailing from Macon Georgia USA, Hughes Taylor was immediately drawn to the blues when he first picked up the guitar. Two decades later, he's become an acclaimed guitarist and songwriter playing a fiery brand of blues-rock whose power trio lineage stretches back to Stevie Ray Vaughan, Cream and Jimi Hendrix.

His latest studio album, Modern Nostalgia, is a showcase not only of his signature style as a guitarist but of his overall evolution as a musician, songwriter, and producer. Written during the pandemic and recorded at the legendary Capricorn Sound Studios, it's a sweet mix of blues, blues-rock, and southern rock; a modern successor to the great music that put Capricorn on the map many years ago. Modern Nostalgia was released on CD in July 2021 and has been on the US Blues-Rock Top 50 Album Chart every week for the past 16 months. A limited-edition double vinyl edition was released in June, 2022.

From age 13, locked away in his bedroom, Hughes practiced for hours on end playing along with his favorite guitar heroes. By 14 he was writing his own material and recording demos in his parents' basement, while simultaneously developing his live act by playing anywhere anytime with anyone. He was performing professionally before he could legally drive, and by the time he started college, creating and performing music was his primary source of income.

He self-released his first full-length album of original songs, Hear My Melody, in the spring of 2016. Restless followed in early 2018, sandwiched between graduating with honors in marketing from University of North Georgia and marrying the love of his life. By the summer of 2019, The Hughes Taylor Band's sound began to coalesce, combining his spin on the bluesrock power trio format with the inescapable influence of his hometown heroes, the Allman Brothers. Good Blues, Fast, an album of classics lovingly arranged and interpreted by Taylor was his first release to gain acclaim beyond Georgia and paved the way for the next chapter in his music journey.

In January of 2020, Hughes and his band toured the United Kingdom supporting the Heather Findlay Band. Gaining immediate popularity and positive music press reviews, the trio returned stateside just as the pandemic halted all tours and local performances. Fortunately, the last few shows of the tour were recorded, affording enough good material for the Live in the UK album he released in early 2021.



Our friend needs our help to recover from a life changing motorcycle accident.



CHRIS O'LEARY - THE HARD LINE



The former lead singer/harp player of Levon Helm's Barn Burners, Chris O'Leary has enjoyed a stellar career as a frontman since his bandleader's passing, but achieves an entirely new level of success with this sensational contemporary blues release, his first album in five years and his debut as a member of the Alligator

O'Leary simply blazes at the mic and on the reeds here as he delivers 12 original slow-burners and fiery shuffles packed with emotion and intense memories culled from previous careers as a U.S. Marine and federal police officer. Chris Vitarello and Greg Gumpel shine on guitars, and Monster Mike Welch makes a guest appearance, too.




DANIELLE NICOLE - THE LOVE YOU BLEED

One of the busiest bluesmen in the world, Arizona-based harp player/producer Bob Corritore closed out 2023 with the release of this compilation - the fourth of the year - while taking a break from his normal format by featuring nine vocalists from his adopted home state. And like the previous efforts, the former Chicagoan soars on harp in the background throughout and it's a winner on all counts.

The Phoenix area might not be on your radar as a blues mecca, but you'll be putting it on your list after listening to this set, which includes former Howlin' Wolf drummer Chico Chism, King Karl, Sugaray Rayford, Dave Riley, Big Pete Pearson, George Bowman, Tommy Dukes, Dino Spells and Chief Schabuttie Gilliame backed by some of the biggest names in the business.

Treat yourself to "Big Fat Woman 489 Lbs.," "Come to Me Baby," "Walking in the Park," "Jennie Bea," "I Was a Fool," "Real Bad Day," "Leopard Speckled Baby," "Laughing Blues," "The Glide" and "I'm Evil."

Cassius King has chosen to spend the past 25 years toiling for others in the control room to support his family rather than to pursue his own music career. But one listen to this traditional blues disc will prove beyond a shadow of a doubt that stardom truly was awaiting him if he'd only taken the chance.

Based out of Southern California, he's an expressive, powerful vocalist who shines on keys here with equally impressive backing by the magnificent Chalo Ortiz on guitar, Chris White on bass and J.R. Lozano on drums.

It isn't often that you'll find an EP in this column, but this one is definitely worth the space. Composed of four originals and one cover, give Cassius a listen as he debuts with "Do It All Again," "If You Love Me," "Feel Good Music," "Better Man Blues" and 'Last Call for the Blues."



Bob Margolin was wielding at Gibson archtop guitar when he joined the Muddy Waters Band 50 years ago, and he celebrates that anniversary by bringing out the axe for all of the tracks on this CD, an intimate effort on which he contributing all of the sounds except the barking of his border collie Levon on one tune.

Truly a one-man show, Bob also handled recording, mixing and mastering duties in a set that includes six of tunes he either played or recorded with Muddy and four of his own originals, all of which were reworked in order for him both to play on the instrument solo and to play acoustic.

An outstanding labor of love, give a listen to "Going Down to Main Street," "The Shape I'm In," "Mean Old Chicago," "Lonely Man Blues," "Baby Can't Be Found," "For You My Love," "No Consolation" and "Just Before Dawn."




THE BLASTERS - MANDATORY: THE BEST OF THE BLASTERS

Since their inception in 1979, the Blasters -- led by vocalist Phil Alvin and his younger brother Dave, who's served as the primary songwriter -- have provided to be major players in American roots. Fusing an eclectic mix of blues, rock, jazz and more, this beefy, 21-track set features many of their hits and a few surprises, too. Most of the songs here come from their heyday -- the early to mid-'80s -- but also include cuts from the Walter Hill cult film, Streets of Fire, and more, most of which are fast-paced efforts propelled by their longtime rhythm section, bassist John Bazz and drummer Bill Bateman.

Crank this one up and give a listen to "American Music," "Flat Top Joint," "I'm Shakin'," "So Long Baby Goodbye," "Hollywood Bed," "One Bad Stud," "Jubilee Train," "Trouble Bound," "Dark Night," "Common Man" and "Kathleen."







11 GUYS QUARTET - 11 X 11



Friends and bandmates from the Boston music scene since the '70s, the oddly named 11 Guys Quartet delivered a pleasing all-instrumental album, Small Blues and Grooves, in 2020 after a 35-year break from the studio. And they return in style - and add a couple of vocals, too - with this rock-solid collection of traditional but contemporary tunes.

They're fronted by guitarist/vocalist Paul Lenart, who toured with Big Mama Thornton and T-Bone Walker and was a longtime member of Beantown's beloved James Montgomery Band, and harp player Richard Rosenblatt, the industry veteran who founded both the Tone-Cool and VizzTone labels.

RED HOT'n BLUES REVIEWS by Marty Gunther


Former board member Marty Gunther has moved from Charlotte, but he remains dedicated to the CBS family. A musical nomad who grew up in Rhode Island and attended App State, his baptism to the blues came while listening to Muddy Waters at the 1960 Newport Folk Festival. A longtime member of the Chicago Blues community, he was taught harmonica by Sugar Blue before founding the Nucklebusters, a fixture in South Florida since the late '80s. An in-demand journalist with broad knowledge across the music spectrum, his "Red Hot 'n Blues" column also appears monthly in Chicago Blues Guide and he serves as senior writer at Blues Blast magazine and a contributor to the newsletter of Crossroads Blues Society (III.), too.
