

National Blues Museum Hosting Events for Grand Opening







	Damon Fowler					
Thur, 3/17 (9:00 Show) \$10	After spending much of the past year touring with the band Southern Hospitality, Damon Fowler is back with his third solo project for Blind Pig Records, Sounds of Home. Damon chose swamp blues master Tab Benoit to produce and record him at Tab's rural Louisiana home studio, and their collaboration has resulted in Damon's strongest effort to date On the strength of his hybrid of roots rock, blues, and sacred steel, the Florida native started wowing audiences with his musical exploits as a teenager, building a reputation as one of the hottest young players on the scene. Adding songwriting and vocal skills to his repertoire over the years has brought him many accolades, with critics extolling his originality and maturity as well as his technical guitar expertise. Fowler's guitar work has been compared to Johnny Winter and Jeff Beck, while his slide guitar has a hint of the late Duane Allman.

Thu, 3/31 (9:00 Show) \$8	Luxuriant Sedans is a brand new band from the fertile musical stomping grounds of the North Carolina Piedmont. The band's five members are veteran musicians with experience in a myriad of musical genres — from alternative music to country-rock to jazz, vintage soul and rock 'n' roll in all its forms and guises. The common ground for their backgrounds is blues but The Luxuriant Sedans is no typical fedora-wearing, licks-off-of-records blues band. Rather, the band's deep musical versatility takes the blue soul in its music and adds an element of rock 'n' roll energy that celebrates taste and individuality.

The Double Door Inn presents Zydeco Legend Buckwheat Zydeco

American musical legend Stanley "Buckwheat" Dural Jr. (a.k.a. Buckwheat Zydeco) is the preeminent ambassador of Louisiana's zydeco music. If you've gotten into zydeco music, or felt its influence, or watched the world celebrate this great aspect of Louisiana culture over the past 30+years, it's likely been because of Buckwheat Zydeco.

The band celebrated its 30th anniversary in 2009, and capped it with the release of the Grammy Award-winning Alligator CD, <u>Lay Your Burden Down</u>. In February of 2010 the album won for Best Zydeco or Cajun Music Album. Buckwheat Zydeco had been nominated four previous times in three different categories. This was the band's first Grammy win.

Over the course of Buckwheat Zydeco's career, Buck has gigged with everyone from Eric Clapton (with whom Buckwheat also recorded) and U2 to The Boston Pops. The band performed at the closing ceremonies of the 1996 Summer Olympics to a worldwide audience of three billion people. Buckwheat even performed at both of President Clinton's Inaugurals, and has had numerous national television appearances.
