



Welcome to the Charlotte Blues Society 2024 -25 Blues Talent Competition Official Entry Form

The International Blues Challenge (IBC) represents the worldwide search for blues bands and solo/duo blues performers ready for the international stage, yet just needing that extra big break. The world's largest gathering of blues musicians will take place on Beale Street, with over 20 clubs hosting the challengers and fans. In addition to featuring these final rounds of the prestigious blues music competition, the IBC event week will offer seminars, showcases, master classes, film screenings, networking events, book signings, and receptions for blues societies, fans, and professionals.

The 40th International Blues Challenge

is scheduled for January 7-11, 2025 in downtown Memphis, TN, taking place in the Historic Beale Street Entertainment District

The Charlotte winners in Band and Solo/Duo will represent CBS in Memphis:

There are two categories in which acts may compete

- Solo/Duo Competition
 - Band Competition

At least one member must be 18 or older to enter the Band or Solo/Duo competition or registration must be completed by a guardian. Our competition will be held Sunday October 6, 2024. The venue is the Neighborhood Theatre, Charlotte, NC

• We will also be sponsoring a Youth Showcase act to Memphis.

If you wish to be considered for the youth act, please contact us immediately. We will walk you through the process. All Youth <u>must be under 21</u> as of Jan. 7, 2025. Youth acts play in a Beale Street showcase and receive feedback however, they are not judged.

Another category in which you may participate is the Best Self-produced CD

Best Self-produced CD

Only CDs released between November 1, 2023 and October 31, 2024 are eligible for consideration as the 2025 Best Self-Produced CD. Please review the rules on Blues.org/self-produced-cd-award/

Entry fee is \$50 per Band, Solo/Duo is \$35 per act, which includes Band affiliation / membership in the Charlotte Blues Society. There is no fee for Youth or CD entries. The membership covers all act/band members for one year and offers each all the privileges awarded any member of the Society.





Eligibility

An Act is eligible as long as it, or any member of the act, has never received a Blues Music Award nomination.

An Act may enter the IBC a maximum of 3 times, after which they are no longer eligible.

An Act may *not* participate in the IBC in three (3) consecutive years. i.e., there must be a break of at least one year after competing in a first or second IBC.

The Blues Foundation reserves the right to determine what constitutes a new act on a case by case basis. (e.g., a band leader would not be eligible for another 2 attempts by changing one or two back up musicians and changing the band's name. Similarly, a solo musician could not enter the solo/duo category after 2 attempts by adding a partner to form a duo)

A musician may not compete in the band category and the solo/duo category in the same year at the IBC, even if the musician represents a different affiliate in each.

Affiliates may set their own rules regarding musicians playing in more than one act in their local challenge. (cont.)

Any act, band or solo/duo, that has won first place at the IBC in Memphis may not enter a challenge in that same category in the future.

An individual musician who has won the IBC as a solo performer may not re-enter as part of a duo, nor can a member of an IBC winning duo then enter as a solo performer.

The winning act in a particular category in the local challenge must enter in that same category for the IBC, i.e., if a band wins the local challenge, one or two musicians from the band cannot enter the solo/duo category at the IBC.

Acts may enter the challenge of any affiliate within 250 miles of the home affiliate. Acts are not permitted to enter more than 2 affiliates in competition year.

Affiliates may establish their own regional boundaries as long as those boundaries do not exceed The Blues Foundation's 250 mile radius.

Acts may be invited to participate in the challenge, but they may not be "pre-selected" and must compete in a fair event.

If a winning act withdraws before registering for the IBC, affiliates may send the act that placed second in the local challenge. If the act withdraws after registering for the IBC, a replacement may not be entered.





All members of the winning act must attend the IBC. Should unexpected circumstances arise (i.e., illness, family emergencies, etc.) no more than one member or any band may be replaced.

The winner of each category will go on to represent the Charlotte Blues Society in the Blues Foundation's 2025 International Blues Challenge (IBC) in Memphis, Tennessee to be held January 7-11, 2025. This will be the 40th year of the IBC and promises to be exciting and competitive.

The **CBS Competition** will be held at The Neighborhood Theatre, 511 E 36th Street, Charlotte, NC on the following date: **Sunday, October 6, 2024**, exact start time to be determined by Sept 10, 2024.

The Charlotte winners will be expected to play a set at the local **December Holiday Show 2024**. Sponsorships will be awarded at that time.

Registration is between June 1 and September 7, 2024 (5pm, eastern time). Registration may be submitted via email to CLTBluesSociety@gmail.com and will be confirmed by return email.

The undersigned hereby attests that at least one of the competitors listed on this registration form are in fact 18 years of age or older. If not, a parent or guardian must sign the registration form. Note: Youth Showcase acts may be under 18 and must be under 21, please contact CBS for details on how to enter. That all competitors including the Spokesperson for the individual(s) listed on this registration form and identified by real or stage name and herein referred to as the Act. The Act is defined as a soloist or individuals performing together. The undersigned Spokesperson further attests that each person identified as a member of the Act has not appeared on a final Handy/Blues Music Award ballot and the Act has not competed at the Memphis IBC the previous two years representing a Blues Society and/or affiliate, nor competed at the Memphis IBC a total of 3 years. It is further agreed than the undersigned Spokesperson has thoroughly read and understood the eligibility requirements. It is agreed by the Spokesperson that he/she/they and each member of the Act, do hereby exempt from all liability the Charlotte Blues Society and all persons, organizations and companies that are directly or indirectly associated with the Charlotte Blues Society's 2024-25 competition, or International Blues Challenge competition. It is further agreed by the Spokesperson that he/she/they and each member of the Act listed on this registration form permits the Charlotte Blues Society the right to make use of his/her/their names, voices, pictures, visages, and other likenesses of the Act, for the purpose of advertising and promoting the Charlotte Blues Society. The Spokesperson further agrees, that should their Act be the winner they agree to sign a contract with the Charlotte Blues Society regarding acceptance of monies to offset expenses in Memphis and for their performance at the IBC in Memphis. and the return of such Charlotte Blues Society - IBC Entry Form (Revised 5/13/2024) funds should winning Act elect not to participate in the IBC in Memphis
