

Now in his 80s and based in France, Mighty Mo Rodgers is a classically trained keyboard player who's known for highly charged lyrics and a deep social conscience, but he switches gears with this set, a silky smooth statement of love for the sound of blues-drenched soul emanating from Memphis.

This is truly an international effort for Mo, who's the son of a man who owned an important nightclub in East Chicago, Ind. The first seven tunes here were recorded in Italy, France and the U.S. with a lineup that includes Sax Gordon and guitarist Luca Giordano. The remaining four cuts are long-lost treasures captured in Los Angeles for a proposed album in the '70s with backing from the full lineup of Booker T. & the MGs - Booker T. Jones, Steve Cropper, Duck Dunn and Willie Hall.

The golden era of soul lives again through "Memphis Callin'," "Sing for Your Supper," "Love, Love, Love," "The Chitlin Circuit," "If Reincarnation Is True," "The March," "San Francisco (You're a Holiday)," "Indiana (Calls My Name)," "Woman of the Rain" and "Heart Be Still."

DOM MARTIN - BURIED IN THE HAIL



Delivered in trio format with Dom's six-string and vocals riding high atop rocksteady rhythm from bassist Ken Graham and drummer Johnny McIlroy and delivered in a style laid down by Rory Gallagher and Van Morrison, this one will have you sitting up from the jump and taking notice.



himself on kick drums and foot percussion. Callie Sioux, his wife and former partner in the band Gleewood, adds upright bass and harmonica in a highly improvisational set that includes contributions from several regional musicians.
