Join us for Ally's Money & Power tour as she shares her new studio album *Money & Power* releasing April 2025 on Ruf Records

Rules are there to be broken. Expectations are there to be defied. Glass ceilings are there to be shattered. Having spent the past decade carving out her own unique space in the male-dominated world of blues-rock, Ally Venable's combative sixth album, *Money & Power*, demands more of both – for herself, for women around the world, and for anyone else who thought they weren't worthy of a seat at the table.

"Money & Power is such a strong statement, especially for women," says the award-winning Texas gunslinger of her Nashville-recorded new release, on which Ally's crack-squad band is joined by A-list guests Shemekia Copeland and Christone 'Kingfish' Ingram. "All the songs on this album showcase the theme of what it truly means to be a force to be reckoned with. I want this record to wake people up."

In February 2024, *Money & Power* sessions saw Ally and producer/drummer Tom Hambridge push through the doors of Nashville's famous Soundstage Studios. Led by the guitarist's burnt-honey vocal and soulful fretwork, the studio band was a wish list of first-call musicians, including Isaac Pulido (drums), EJ Bedford (bass/keys), Kenny Greenberg (guitars), Rob Coreton (bass), Luke Mosely (keys), Tim Lauer (keys), Jorion Dawson (saxophone) and Jason Grant (trumpet), all topped off by the backing vocals of Rachel & Sarah Hambridge.

"My favorite part of making this album," reflects Ally, "was having the opportunity to work with all the talented musicians that played on it."

"Making this album felt very therapeutic, as well as a milestone in my musical journey," she says of the 11 originals (plus a hard-driving cover of Janet Jackson's Black Cat). "I hope these songs allow people to see into my life in a vulnerable way and hold a strong perspective that empowers women and breaks the glass ceiling."

Money & Power is a modern roots record that plays by its own rules and marches to the beat of its own drum. The same could be said for Ally herself. "I'm thrilled to release this album," she says. "For me, it's a sonic embodiment of a woman's unstoppable ambition, and really showcases my musicality on all fronts. I'm looking forward to seeing where this one will take me."

Captured at Delmark's Riverside Studio the old-fashioned way...analog and in one take, it's an all-instrumental outing with Johnny reworking tunes by Little Brother Montgomery, Mel London, Chuck Berry, Magic Sam and Jay McShann and tossing in five powerhouse originals of his own.

Surprisingly slow and gentle, you'll enjoy "Lilli May," "Pass It to the Right," "Sanguine," "One Monkey," the Latin-flavored "Oh What a Night," "Wrong Hands," "Too Damned Slow," "The Artist" and "Just the Way It Is."







The album that he produced here would make gospel and blues singer Sister Rosetta Tharpe break out into a broad smile. Brian Templeton (The Proven Ones) delivers harp and shares vocalist with Kid's son, Johnny, with backing from Dave Limina (Ronnie Earl) on keys, Stephen Hodges (Mavis Staples) on drums and Mike Turturro (The 44s) on drums. Add horns and accordion and you've got something special.

A mix of covers and new tunes compiled by Templeton, raise your spirits with "Strange Things Happening Everyday," "How I Got Over," "I'm Working on a Building," "Oh What a Meeting," "An Answer for Isaac," "Satan's Jeweled Crown," "Nobody But the Lord," "More Love More Power" and "I'm a Pilgrim."



Think you've heard ALL of B.B. King? Well, you're in for a treat! Originally recorded by France's national radio agency, this set sat in storage for 45 years but is an absolute treasure because it provides a time capsule that catches him working with what became the B.B. King Orchestra for the first time.

Prior to this recording and since the early '60s, he'd toured with backing from drummer Sonny Freeman and Freeman's band, the Unusuals. But this unit is chockful of what now are familiar bandmates and names: B.B.'s nephew/bandleader Walter King, Cato Walker III, Eddie Rowe, James Toney, Milton Hopkins, Calep Emphrey Jr. and others.

Don't miss this skintight set, which includes "Blue Monk," "Sweet Little Angel," "I Like to Live the Love," "Why I Sing the Blues," "I Got Some Outside Help (I Don't Really Need)," "The Thrill Is Gone" and extended takes of "I Need My Baby" and "Sweet Sixteen" and other pleasers.



Former board member Marty Gunther has moved from Charlotte, but he remains dedicated to the CBS family. A musical nomad who grew up in Rhode Island and attended App State, his baptism to the blues came while listening to Muddy Waters at the 1960 Newport Folk Festival. A longtime member of the Chicago Blues community, he was taught harmonica by Sugar Blue before founding the Nucklebusters, a fixture in South Florida since the late '80s. An in-demand journalist with broad knowledge across the music spectrum, his "Red Hot 'n Blues" column also appears monthly in Chicago Blues Guide and he serves as senior writer at Blues Blast magazine and a contributor to the newsletter of Crossroads Blues Society (II.), too.


