With live music from noon to 7:30pm on 2 stages, this event is open to all ages and presented free of charge by the Charlotte Blues Society with sponsorship from Bojangles.

You are invited to join them for this Live Roots and Blues music event featuring a variety of styles from Blues-Rock to Acoustic. Headliners are the Lenny Federal Band, and the Pam Taylor Band, with performances by Melissa McKinney, the Fool Hardies, Mojo Stomp, Misti Mayhem, Jackson Slater, Andy Kushner, Will Ellis & Lynnette Barber Duo, Susanne Smith, the Pszenny Project, and the Blues Nomads with support from Deja Blues and the Rockaholics. The festival is hosted at Heist Brewery & Barrel Arts, 1030 Woodward Ave (Camp North End) in Charlotte, NC 28206. They will host an open blues jam in the Skyline Room after the last act.
