- D. Volunteer forms- All have been turned in.
- E. Sponsor Banner- All logos have been submitted. We discussed adding the companies that donated passes for the PTO drive families (Defy, Fly High etc.)
- F. 2nd quarter raffle winner- Tossava family won the 2nd quarter raffle prize. They won 4 ice skating passes and 4 ice skating rentals.
- G. Gator Gear- Some Gator Gear requests are still coming in. We discussed changing the sweater color or maybe a logo too. We are hesitant to order a lot just in case we can't sell. But the more we order the better price we get.
- H. Pizza Factory give back nights- Tonight December 7th is a give back night the check from October is still not in. Angie said she will contact the owner if she has not heard from him in the next couple weeks.
- I. Yogurt beach give back nights- First give back night we made \$110. Our next give back night is March 18th.
