Photography Pre-Shoot Checklist

KITCHEN AND DINING AREA

	Declutter, clean countertops and sink. Put away dishes and small appliances. Remove magnets/photos from refrigerator. Clean surface of large appliances such as stove, refrigerator, microwave, etc.		Sweep and mop the floor. Remove towels, trash cans, and throw rugs. Hide pet bowls, beds, pet food, toys, etc.

	Dust surfaces (tablets, shelves, t.v. etc).		Remove blankets from furniture.		
	Tidy bookshelves. Remove personal photos.		Vacuum or sweep and scrub floors.		
	Hide cables from t.v., stereo, phone chargers, etc.		Vacuum sofa/chairs. Fluff pillows.		
BATHROOM					
	Clean shower, tub, sink, toilet, etc.		Remove throw rugs and towels.

	Declutter, put detergents and cleaners away. Organize.

HOME OFFICE				
	Dust surfaces.			
	Declutter, clear desk.			
	Organize and straighten items and hide electronic cables.			
	Sweep/vacuum.			
EX	TERIOR			
	Mow grass 2-3 days prior. Remove clippings from walkways.			
	Remove bicycles, toys, and any other clutter from the yard.			
	Put away garbage cans, hoses, garage tools, etc.			
MISCELLANEOUS				
	Declutter every room.			
	Remove personal photos.			
	Replace burned out light bulbs.			
	Put clothes, shoes, etc. in closets and close doors.			
	Remove throw rugs in house.

Turn ON all lights.

Remove cars from the driveway or street in front of the house.

Close all garage doors.
