



**COVID-19
RELEASE AND WAIVER**

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY, THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER OF CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS. Each individual 18 years of age and older visiting a Metro Parks and Nature facility is required to understand and sign this release. Parents/Guardians must sign this release for and be responsible for their children. In consideration for access to Metro Parks and Nature facilities and premises, the Visitor, signing below, agrees as follows:

COVID-19 NOTICE. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness, personal injury, permanent disability, and death. COVID-19 is transmitted from one person to another via breathing, coughing, sneezing, talking, physical contact with a person who has the virus, or via contact with objects touched by that person. Visitor agrees to conduct a health self-assessment prior to visiting and utilizing a Metro facility. Visitor agrees not to visit if experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, including fever, cough, or shortness of breath, or if the Visitor has a suspected, diagnosed, or confirmed case of COVID-19. Visitor agrees not to visit within 14 days of exposure to any person who has a suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19.

COVID 19 RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY. An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in public places where people are present, including Metro Parks and Nature facilities and premises. Visitor voluntarily and knowingly assumes all risks related to exposure to COVID-19, including but not limited to the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 as a result of the acts, omissions, or negligence of other Metro employees, volunteers, users, and visitors of Metro Parks and Nature facilities and premises. Visitor agrees not to sue Metro, its elected officials, officers, employees, volunteers, and agents for any loss or damage, and any claim or demands on account of any personal injury, illness, requirement to quarantine, permanent disability, or death, and agrees to release, hold harmless, and indemnify Metro from all COVID-19 claims by or on behalf of Visitor against Metro, its elected officials, officers, employees, volunteers, and agents. Visitor agrees to respect and abide Oregon Health Authority guidance for parks as follows:

- Face coverings are required indoors
- Face coverings are required in outdoor public spaces when physical distancing is not possible
- Children age 5 and up are required to wear a face covering
- Group sizes must be limited to 10 or fewer people
- Maintain at least 6 feet of physical distance between parties (groups of 10 or fewer people arriving at the site together)

Visitors are encouraged to:

- Bring their own food, water bottles, and hygiene supplies (including hand sanitizer)
- Frequently wash or sanitize hands
- Practice physical distancing
