

## Community Culture Agreement

TLC R3 Camping Retreat is open to confirmed participants who agree to the Community Culture Agreement developed by Transformative Living Community, International (TLC Int'l). To ensure safety and comfort of all, camping participants agree to abide by a Community Culture Agreement (CLA) by which we can camp together in peace.

As a community camper, I agree to:

1. Ensure all shared spaces (camp grounds, shelters, pathways, grass areas) are clean and easily accessible for the health and safety of all.
2. Respect park policy by complying with speed limits, noise levels of music while driving, pets, smoking/drinking, fire safety, behaviors and activities conducted at both the reserved group site and other park shelters, recreational areas, etc.
3. Recognize, respect and honor differences in cultural norms, values and beliefs, with particular care and mindfulness to possible previous traumas and life experiences.
4. Behave with honesty and integrity when communicating and interacting with others both within the group camp area and outside of the reserved area.
5. Practice non-violence (both physical and verbal,) anti-racism, and equity towards others through respectful action and speech.
6. If conflict does arise, make an honest effort to offer repairs to restore right relationships according to the comfort and reasonable satisfaction of the harmed party(s).

Failure to abide by one or more guidelines will result in a verbal notice. If an incident occurs a second time, the camper will be asked to leave the retreat.
