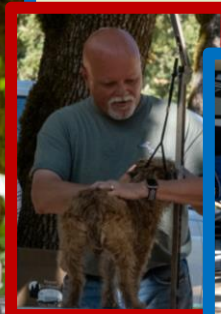
SUMMER PICNIC FUN – A SUCCESS!

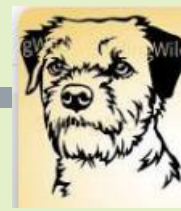
MEET A MEMBER: MOLLY BREDENBERG

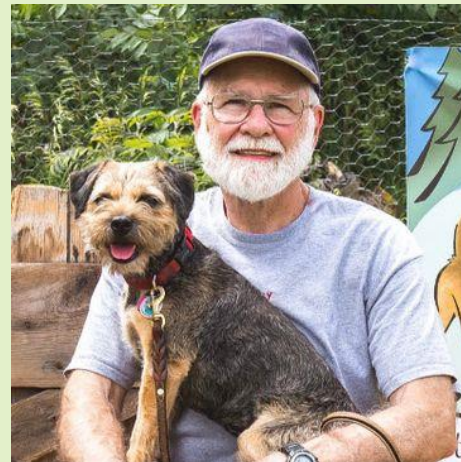
