It is with great sadness that I deliver the news that friend and club member Susan Harvey has passed away after a brief battle with brain cancer.


Susan loved to read, loved Pete (her Tilted Kilt Border Terrier), her cats and garden. She is survived by her daughter and husband Russell.

There was one response and that was for a hands-on seminar to work on the harder areas such as the neck and ears.











RALLY FUN MATCH PICTURES
