The Border Terrier Club of Oregon (BTCO) will hold an Instructional Border Terrier Grooming Seminar, **presented by Casey DePriest** for anyone learning, practicing or wanting to improve their stripping and grooming skills for their Border Terrier. This seminar is for the human side of your team.

Date: Saturday, September 26th, 2026

Location: 24491 S. Larkin Rd., Beavercreek, OR (Tom & Marie Quarles' place)

Time: 10:00am to 3:00pm - with a 30 minute lunch break (you bring your own)
Start arriving at 9:30am – Late registrations may be taken then.

The seminar will include these and more:

- Introduction to stripping the Border Terrier;
- Striping and grooming for pet and show, from puppy to senior aged dogs;
- Stripping and grooming tools, what they are and how they are used;
- Grooming terms and descriptions;
- Tips and techniques stripping;
- Questions and Answers

Casey will prearrange for and provide all dogs, equipment and tools that will be used at this seminar.
General attendees are asked to not bring their dogs to the seminar.

{If you need to have your dog travel with you and be at the site, they may stay in your vehicle or, if quiet, may be crated with you.}

Directions to the Seminar (24491 S Larkin Road, Beavercreek, OR):

Heading either South bound or North bound on I-205:

- Take exit 10 for OR-213 toward Mollala/Oregon City
 - Follow OR-213 for about 3 miles
 - Turn left at Beavercreek Road; follow Beavercreek Road about 3.7 miles
 - In downtown Beavercreek, Beavercreek Road makes a 90 degree left turn at a 4-way intersection. Make the Left turn to stay on Beavercreek Road.
 - Continue about 5 more miles on Beavercreek Road.
 - Turn Right on S Larkin Road.
 - There will be a sign on the telephone pole beside the driveway for 24491 – turn Right just in front of the telephone pole with the sign and go down the LONG driveway. The driveway splits into 2 driveways. There is a gate to the right-hand side of the driveway – this is the neighbors', please do not disrupt them.
 - The driveway eventually turns to the left. Parking will be at right angles to the driveway past that left turn.
