Payments

A registration fee of \$150 is due upon application submission and is non-refundable.

Book/Curriculum fees of \$450 as well as Testing fees of \$150 are due **August 1st** of the school year the student will be attending, *or day of acceptance if after August 1st.*

In cases where scholarships such as McKay, Step-Up, Hope, or Gardiner Scholarships are awarded, balance due are the sole responsibility of the parent/guardian and will be required to be paid-in-full or scheduled payments through FACTs with the Financial Office at Largo Christian School, prior to the first day of school.

Payment plans are ONLY available through FACTs Management System and handled only ONLINE. Once a student is enrolled, the payment of tuition and fees for the full academic year is an unconditional obligation. Payments not received on or before due dates will place a student's ongoing education at jeopardy; students may be asked to leave Largo Christian School until payments are current, as transfer paperwork will be denied, diplomas will be withheld, and/or loss of scholarship (according to the official scholarship handbook) can occur with a failure of non-payment to Largo Christian School.

No portion of tuition or fees paid will be refunded or canceled notwithstanding the absence, withdrawal or dismissal of a student from Largo Christian School during the academic year without prior approval of the Financial Office at Largo Christian School or by notifying the Admissions Offices at Largo Christian School in writing on or before July 15th preceding the school year that the student will not re/enroll.

Additional Charges

In cases of requested back-to-school supplies, field trips, sports participation, before/after care services, and damaged/lost books, additional charges will be incurred and billed accordingly.

Student forgetting their lunches will be given a generic meal and families will be charged \$2. (Please remember this is only for emergencies and not a daily lunch plan.)

Late Payments

If a student's account is in arrears at the end of any grading period, the student's report card and/or diploma will be held until the account is current, to which then the Financial Office will release access. If this happens, the best recommendation is to contact Largo Christian School's finance office and notify them of the situation; allowing costs to increase without notification is never the best course of action.

There is a \$25.00 per item fee on any/all returned payments.
