Show and Competition Rules

- All exhibitors to be 17 years or younger on show day and must pen their own exhibits.
- All exhibits are eligible for Bird of Show except under 8's classes.
- Only exhibitors winning 1 of the 7 Champion Awards will be eligible to progress to the NSW State Junior Championship Competition and must be aged between 8 and 17 years of age on the show day.
- The eligible entrants for the NSW State Junior Championship Exhibitor Award will be asked to answer questions from a judging panel. The winner of this competition will be one who best answers questions from the Australian Standard Edition 2 in relation to their winning bird, Show Preparation, breeding Poultry and Poultry Husbandry.
- Students from schools with poultry may borrow birds for the competition from their school.
- Exhibitors are allowed to borrow birds from their school bird but must state the name of the school on the entry form.
- All exhibits are to be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor or the exhibitor's school.
- Any breed that isn't in the Australian Standard will be judged first under the British Standard then American Standard.
- Birds will not be allowed to be handled without the permission of the chief steward from 9am until unpenning.
- Judging will be open and anyone acting unfavorably will be asked to leave the pavilion.
- Spurs are to be trimmed and if not, the Judge reserves the right to not handle the bird.
- The Club Executive reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason.
- All care will be taken; however, the club will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may arise from any cause to persons and/or exhibits.
- All eggs are the property of the club, and all drinkers are to be supplied by the Club.
- **Bio Security** (to help protect your birds and other exhibitor's birds)
 - Do not pen unhealthy or vermin infected birds, as you will be asked to remove them.
 - Do not touch other exhibitor's birds, eggs, and waterers, especially waterfowl.
 - Only use drinkers supplied by the Mudgee Club as they have been disinfected.
 - Only use the chlorinated town water available at the pavilion.
 - Use the hand sterilizer supplied.

Penning and Unpenning

- Penning will be from 3pm to 6.00pm on the Friday and from 7am to 8.45am on the Saturday.
- Pen numbers will be provided to the exhibitor on arrival at the pavilion.
- Judging to start at 9am sharp.
- No birds will be accepted after judging has commenced.
- All exhibitors must be accompanied by a steward when unpenning.
- Unpenning priority will be given to visitors who have travelled long distances.
- Anyone staying Saturday night may leave their birds in the Pavilion and pick them up Sunday with prior approval of the Show Secretary.
