What is this?

A fund created to help our team members during times of personal crisis using donations from fellow team members and the company

What are the events that qualify an employee to receive money from the fund?

- Home catastrophe/Natural disaster: Employee's home is destroyed or rendered unlivable by a natural disaster
- Funeral expense: To help an employee who is financially responsible for paying the funeral expenses or an immediate family member or in the case of the death of an employee, to help their immediate family member who is financially responsible for paying the funeral expenses.
- Donation matching grant: For personal catastrophe that does not meet the eligible grant criteria and co-workers have raised funds to help the employee.

How much can I get?

There are 2 types of grants:

- Up to \$1,000 to help cover funeral expenses or a home catastrophe.
- Matching funds up to \$500 when employees raised money for their team member in need.

How can I apply?

How can I donate money to the fund?

You can sign up to have money deducted via payroll at anytime through Dayforce benefits. Enrollment is found in your new hire event, annually in the open enrollment event, and anytime through the DTE I Care Contribution event.
